TORAH COMES ALIVE

Classes run in two ten-week cycles, and each class focuses on specific themes that rotate each semester. Themes include Torah stories, the Jewish calendar and holidays, Shabbat, prayers and blessings, the Hebrew alphabet, basic Hebrew skills, mitzvot, and Jewish values. Students who return year after year will develop a strong foundation on which to build their future participation in the community through adolescence and into adulthood.

Using a variety of modalities including music, art, storytelling, meditation, and drama, our fun and engaging classes will deepen students' connections to the rhythms of Jewish life and the cycles of the seasons. Students will explore the spiritual side of Judaism through direct experiences with meditation, chant, and contemplative practices. Together we will engage in mitzvah projects that allow us to put our values into action and collaborate in building *tikkun olam* (repair of the world).

BUILDING COMMUNITY

Our school programs are integrated into the wider variety of experiences offered at Chochmat HaLev. Because building community is central to Chochmat's mission, **families enrolled in our school are expected to:**

- Attend at least half of the classes with their child/ren (ten weeks per year) and help in the classroom
- Attend two or more Shabbat and/or holiday services per semester
- Volunteer ten hours per year in the greater CHL community (Volunteer opportunities will be presented at the beginning of each semester. Families unable to make these commitments are asked to make a one-time contribution of \$75 to the school.)
- Participate in CHL's family programs

PROGRAM DETAILS

Classes meet on Tuesday afternoons from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. at Chochmat Ha Lev, 2215 Prince St. in Berkeley. The first semester, beginning in September 2009, will cover 10 weeks between September and December 2009. The second semester will cover 10 weeks between January and May 2010.
